

Intranet V5 Installation Summary

Before Installation.

1. Requirements

Ensure that the computer on which you wish to install the IntraNet software meets the minimum system requirements. If you wish to know exactly what is required in order to successfully run IntraNet, please click on the “System Requirements” menu option, located on the left side of the main help page.

2. Port Availability

By default, Intranet is set to run on port 80. Internet Information Services must be disabled in order for IntraNet to run on this port. To turn off IIS, follow the following steps:

- a. Go to Start -> Settings -> Control Panel -> Add/Remove Programs.
- b. Click on the tab on the left side of the Add/Remove Programs window marked “Add/Remove Windows Components”.
- c. Ensure ‘IIS’ is UNCHECKED.
- d. Click ‘Next’ to uninstall.

You may also decide to run IntraNet through a port other than 80 (e.g. 8080). Ensure you have no other services running on the desired port.

3. Which Database?

There is currently support for 3 types of database you may use with the IntraNet software - PostGreSQL, which is included with the package, MSSQL and Oracle.

Installation

To begin, close all programs currently running on your computer and run the IntraNet ‘Setup’ file.

You will now be taken through a number of steps to allow you to customize your installation, including type of database, your name, your company name and a password to allow the Administrator of IntraNet to use the diagnostic tool included with the package.

When the installation has completed, you will be required to access the IntraNet login page in order to begin the database ‘Pre-Load’ portion of the installation process. This may be done by:

- a. Double click the 'IntraNet v5 Login' icon on your desktop.
- b. Open your browser (Internet Explorer, Firefox etc) and in the address bar enter: <http://localhost:PORT>
'PORT' will be **80** unless you specified a different port during installation.

At the top you will see a link marked 'Begin Database Pre-Load'. Click on this to begin loading the database required by IntraNet.

Post-Installation

When the database has completed its pre-load sequence, you can now click on the link 'Bring Me to IntraNet' in order to access your new IntraNet installation. You may do this using the username 'admin' with password 'admin'.
